1-1. Purpose.

1-4. General.

a. The proponents identified for publications in FH Pam 25-31 are those listed in the publication itself. Due to reorganizations, the names of some offices listed may have changed. If you are having difficulty identifying or contacting a proponent, call the Directorate of Information Management, Information Support Services Branch, extension 3-2931.

b. Applicability of publications. Publications are now distributed electronically. Previously -

(1) Publications that apply to the USAIC&FH staff and all tenant organizations were distributed to A or B level (see paragraph 1-5).

(2) Publications that apply only to the USAIC&FH staff were distributed to the U or T level (see paragraph 1-5).

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c. Proponents of publications that are no longer required will notify this office, ATZS-IMO-IP, in writing to rescind the publication. Publications will be rescinded by circulars published by this office when they are not superseded by a new publication.

d. Obsolete publications. Publications that have been superseded or rescinded since 25 September 1998 are listed in Chapter 3. This office maintains official historical files on Fort Huachuca publications and can provide information on the history of obsolete publications not listed in this pamphlet.


