MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Policy 120 – Wear of the Physical Fitness Uniform (PFU)

1. Reference AR 670-1, Wear and Appearance of the Military Uniforms and Insignia 1 September 1992.
2. Purpose: To establish the wear of the Physical Fitness Uniform (PFU) for Fort Huachuca.
3. Physical Fitness Training. The PFU is the standard uniform during organized unit physical fitness training. Commanders are authorized to:
 - a. Approve the wear of commercially purchased running shoes and socks.
 - b. Prescribe the wear of the cap, knit, black, and green or black glove inserts or black glove shells during cold weather.
4. Commanders will permit their soldiers to wear commercially purchased spandex shorts beneath their PFU trunks. The shorts will be solid gray or black and will not extend below the top of the knee. The shorts will not bear any commercial markings or patterns.
5. Reflective belts will be worn with the old and new PFU in both summer and winter uniforms at all times when conducting Physical Training. The reflective belt will be worn diagonally over the right shoulder.
6. On post/off post wear. Soldiers may wear any element of the PFU when off duty on or off post. However, they will adhere to the standards of dress posted for installation facilities. The clothing must be clean and serviceable.
7. Other Provisions.
 - a. Wrist/headbands and leg warmers will not be worn with the PFU.
 - b. Soldiers will not be required to purchase optional items for wear with the PFU (i.e., spandex shorts or distinctive unit shirts).

c. The only insignia authorized for wear on the PFU is the Physical Fitness Badge. When worn, it will be placed on the upper left front side of the PFU.
