AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY

The Fort Huachuca TSC supports all Active, National Guard, and Reserve units permanently assigned to the State of Arizona IAW AR 5-9. We also support Arizona college and high school ROTC programs as well as units from other states who are conducting training within Arizona.



TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION

Several TADSS maintained and issued by the TSC requires annual training and certification. The length of training required for certification varies depending on the equipment. Most TADSS require a day or less of training. The HEAT is a two day course and the unit must provide a certified combat lifesaver on the second day of training.

In order to provide the best service possible to our customers, we work directly with units to schedule certification classes that best fit their demanding schedules.

All certification classes require a minimum of five (5) personnel and maximum of ten personnel per class, except for the HEAT. The HEAT requires a minimum of five (5) personnel but limited to a maximum of eight (8) personnel per class.

GRAPHIC TRAINING AIDS

We maintain a large selection of commonly requested graphic training aids (GTA). If we do not have the GTA on-hand that your unit requires, we can order them. Orders normally take two weeks to arrive. We cannot order GTAs that are no longer active. Please contact us in advance to see if we have the GTAs in stock.

No appointment is required to pick up GTAs but units must have an active hand receipt account on file. Individuals requesting or signing for GTAs do not have to be listed on the signature card (DA Form 1687). This applies to GTAs only.

HAND RECEIPT ACCOUNTS

Units receiving TADSS must have an active account with TSC. Accounts require a DA Form 1687 (Signature Card) and the Commander's Assumption of Command orders. Each unit can have a maximum of three (3) signature cards on file; for a total of 12 personnel authorized to request and/or receive equipment. Units must also have an active account to utilize the EST II and HEAT.

RISK ASSESSMENTS

All units must turn-in a risk assessment for all TADSS requiring certification training before equipment issue. This includes the EST II and HEAT. No exceptions will be made.

REQUEST FORM

In order to request TADSS, units must submit the form on the following page to the group email address. Submitting this form will help speed up the process on the date of issue. This applies to the EST II and HEAT also. All requests must be submitted at least five (5) working days before the requested issue date.

1. The unit representative is required to report to the TADSS Distribution Warehouse located at Building 82012 at the time specified by TSC for issue and turn-in of equipment.
2. Failure to keep designated issue and turn-in appointment times by more than 15 minutes, without prior notification, will result in the unit having to reschedule for a different time and/or date or assume a standby status.
3. The unit must have a certified operator, with current certification card, before any of the following TADSS will be issued: (No exceptions will be made)
 - Engagement Skills Trainer II (EST II)
 - HMMWV Egress Assistance Trainer (HEAT)
 - Improvised Munitions Explosive Effects Signature Simulator (IMEESS)
 - Improvised Explosive Device Effects Simulator (IEDES)
 - Multiple Integrated Laser Engagement System (MILES)
 - Small Arms Gunfire Simulator (SAGS) - XM2A
 - Machine Gun Simulator (Improvised Electronics)
 - Artillery Blast Simulator (ABS) - XM10
 - THOR III-T
 - CREW II (Counter Radio Controlled Improvised Explosive Device)
4. All devices, carrying cases and clothing must be clean, dry and free of dirt, debris and powder residue before turn-ins will be accepted.
5. All equipment, to include on-site simulators, must be turned in by the person who signed for the equipment.
6. All units are required to have a four (4) person detail, at a minimum, present for issue and turn-in.
7. DPTMS, Training Division, TSC must have a current copy of the unit Commander's Assumption of Command Orders on file along with no more than three (3) DA Form 1687s.
8. All TADSS requests, to include on-site simulators, must be submitted to TSC using this form.
9. The undersigned acknowledges that they have read and understand the above requirements.




