SUBJECT: Policy Letter 15-066 - Closure of Training Areas to Recreational Activities

1. REFERENCES.

- a. The Sikes Act, 16 USC 670a-670o
- b. AR 385-63, Range Safety


2. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all persons visiting, assigned to, in temporary duty status, or employed on Fort Huachuca (to include family members and guests).

3. POLICY. Effective immediately, Training Areas T1, T2, T3 and Area Z (map attached) will be closed to all hunting and recreational activities, due to Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) contamination. Range Operations recently discovered old records indicating High Explosives were authorized and fired into these training areas. In addition, the US Forest Service recently conducted prescribed burns in these training areas which exposed the ground and confirmed the presence of UXO contamination. IAW AR 385-63, para 1-9, this closure is required to ensure the safety of personnel using Fort Huachuca's training areas for hunting and recreational purposes.

4. This policy is punitive in nature. Failure to abide by this policy is a violation of Article 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice. Violations of this policy by persons not subject to the UCMJ may result in administrative or legal action to include a bar from the installation under Title 18, United States Code, Section 1382.
